


Technique to Paint and Weather Roof Tiles

Gently sand the surface using 220–240 grit sandpaper, and make sure to remove all dust before applying the paint.



Apply a dark grey paint (Tamiya NATO Black was used in the example), ensuring the paint fills all the engraved areas.



Apply a medium grey paint (Vallejo Sea Grey was used in the example), taking care not to fill the engraved areas by using minimal paint on the brush and painting lightly across the surface.





Gently sand the surface with 320-400 grit sandpaper to expose random sections of the dark grey beneath.

Load a small amount of white paint onto a brush, wipe most of it off on a paper towel, then apply random light white streaks using gentle downward strokes.



Apply a yellow/green paint wash (Vallejo Oil Stains was used in the example) to selected random areas.

Complete the process by applying a coat of matt varnish to protect the surface and eliminate any shine.
